

Tweet SSP



Purpose: Tweeting can be a powerful exercise in economic/precise wording and conscientious editing. The goal of “Tweet SSP” is to help students become more conscious of their writing, every word and punctuation mark, and strive for excellence in writing regardless of medium.

- Steps:**
1. Make a Twitter handle that follows this format: @nameSSP
For example: @JaneSSP or @JohnSSP
 2. Follow @WritingSSP.
 3. Tweet once a day about your thoughts, observations and or experiences. You will tweet a total of 15 times, which counts for 15% of your overall grade. Expectations for your tweets:
 - Your writing should be ruthlessly edited. Check your spelling, grammar and punctuation. Make sure your writing is logical, sensible and coherent.
 - Expect the instructor and class to dissect your tweets in class.
 - Mean what you write.
 - Make sure your writing is respectful and thoughtful.
 4. The class will look at tweets for the day every day. We will edit the tweets for content, grammar, spelling and punctuation. This will help us improve as writers and editors.
